

- 1. Which country recently approved issuance of 'Panda bonds' in Chinese currency Pakistan Pakistan Cabinet approves issuance of 'Panda bonds' in Chinese currency. A Panda bond is a Chinese renminbi-denominated bond from a non-Chinese issuer, sold in the People's Republic of China. The first two Panda bonds were issued in October 2005 on the same day by the International Finance Corporation and the Asian Development Bank. Their terms were 1.13 billion yuan of 10-year bonds at a 3.4% yield and 1 billion yuan of 10-year bonds at a 3.4% yield. [04 Jan, 2019]

Luka Modric Soccer Star Luka Modric is from Croatia and won the Champions League with Real Madrid and then guided Croatia to the World Cup final in July, where the midfielder was voted player of the tournament.
